

Professor Sanyu Mojola, Princeton University, presents:

**“Death by Design:
Producing Racial Health Inequality in the Shadow of the Capitol”**



Description: Why and how does racial health inequality persist and get reproduced in the US? Using the case of Washington D.C., and covering 1790-2021, my project examines the mechanisms underlying the social production and reproduction of racialized disease vulnerability, with a special focus on the last 40 years, and the HIV/AIDS-drugs-homicide syndemic.

Sanyu A. Mojola is Professor of Sociology and Public Affairs, the Maurice P. Daring Professor of Demographic Studies and the Director of the Office of Population Research at Princeton University. She received her PhD from the University of Chicago, and was previously on the faculty at the University of Michigan and the University of Colorado Boulder.
